Plant Return Policy

- Shrubs, trees, perennials, roses, fruit trees, berry bushes **zone 4 & lower - May be exchanged up to 1 year from purchase**
- Tender perennials **zone 5 & higher - May be exchanged up to 90 days from purchase**
- Annual flowers, vegetable transplants, herbs, bare root fruit & veg, bulbs, tropical plants, cacti and succulents - **Final Sale**

The original receipt and plant must be presented. Store credit or a replacement plant (depending on availability) will be granted.



Planting Techniques for Trees, Shrubs & Perennials

Planting Location

Determine whether your planting area is full sun, partial sun or full shade. Full sun is more than six hours of light, generally south or west facing. Partial sun is three to five hours of sun, including morning sun locations that are generally east facing. Shade is no direct sun or light filtered through trees, otherwise known as dappled light, as well as the north side of your landscape. Be mindful of trees or other obstacles that could block the sun later in the season.

Also consider the soil conditions in your planting area. Soils made up of clay or fine sediment will have reduced or poor drainage, while low-lying or marshy areas may be too consistently wet for many plants. Some plants thrive in rough rocky conditions while others need soft loamy soils. It's always possible to amend your soil with additions like topsoil, compost, organic fertilizers or sand to improve the conditions for your selected plants. Check the pH balance of your soil to ensure it is in the correct range for your plant.

Planting Procedure

To plant, dig a hole 2-3 times the diameter of your pot and as deep or deeper than the pot's soil level. If the soil in the bottom of the hole is compacted, loosen it, hydrate, and consider adding organic material. Loosen the soil around the edges and inside the planting hole, angling them away from the center. Loosen the sides of your transplant's root ball by gently pulling the roots apart. Mix compost with the soil that was removed from the hole to replenish the nutrient levels. will have positive benefits as well.

Add a handful of bonemeal to the bottom of your hole to encourage root development. Root system growth in the first year is essential for the longevity of the plant, and it's advisable to remove all blossoms from your plant in that year to ensure its energy goes toward developing roots.












Place your plant in the hole and fill halfway with soil. Lightly tamp the soil in place to remove any air pockets, then finish filling in the hole and lightly tamp the soil again. Water in the plant to settle the soil even if the ground or plant is wet. Consider staking tall shrubs and trees in the first year while they develop.

Watering is essential in the first year while roots are developing. Avoid frequent, light waterings that will result in a shallow root system; water deeply to encourage deep-growing roots, especially during the heat of the summer.
